## Parc & Sat Scores – Mr. Kirckpatrick & Mrs. Fallon

- New Jersey expectations are higher at meeting the mark.
- Children should have a 4 or 5 to meeting or exceeding expectations.
- Reading for 9<sup>th</sup> grade was slightly down from the previous year, 10<sup>th</sup> & 11 grades were slightly higher.
- Math for Algebra 1 & Geometry grades were slightly higher from the previous year, & Algebra 2 grades were slightly lower.
- December 31, 2018 it was decided that parce testing will not be needed. However, there is little information that has been decided on the NJ learning assessment.
